RELAY MISSOURI

Relay Missouri is a service that provides full telephone accessibility to people who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind and speech-disabled. It can be used to make telephone calls to family, friends, businesses or anyone who has a phone. The



service is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and 365 days a year. It is accurate and transparent. The operator voices everything you type and types everything you say. All Relay Missouri calls are strictly private. No records of any conversations are maintained. Relay services are available at no charge. Equipment itself is available upon request to eligible parties. The

services are funded by the State. To learn more, visit relaymissouri.com. To use the service, dial 7-1-1 or call the Relay Customer Service Hotline at 800-676-3777 to reach the type of relay needed.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

We're wrapping up Phase 1 of our ReConnect 3 Project, with only final clean-up work remaining. As we move into Phase 2, construction will shift to Rush Hill, Benton City, and the surrounding areas—including regions near Laddonia and west of Mexico along Highway 54.
Construction is expected to begin in November.



Although these areas fall outside the KTC exchange, this project reflects our broader mission to expand fast, reliable fiber internet to rural communities that currently lack access.
